

Kumihimo Workshop with Makiko Tada
Seattle, Washington, USA
October 26 - 29, 2010

Makiko Tada is a researcher, designer, author and maker of kumihimo. She has a Doctor of Engineering from Kyoto Institute of Technology where she is a professor; she is also a lecturer at Nihon Women's University and Yamano College of Aesthetics.

Makiko is a very popular teacher, having taught at numerous conferences and guilds in the United States. She is coming from Japan to teach a four day workshop here in Seattle, Washington.

The classes are open to beginners through advanced students.

Makiko's description of the workshop:

Make various samples of narrow and wide braids with free braiding techniques. Beginners will make various basic braids mainly on Marudai, Kumihimo disk, plate or free techniques. Advanced students may choose any technique they like by consultation beforehand. We will cover more advanced techniques to guide students to a new level. Students both with and without equipment are welcome.

The workshop will run from 9am to 4pm, with a one-hour lunch break. Refreshments will be provided.
