



Goddess of Air - 22 yards of tabletwoven trim form the framework for the loom woven gown. Each edge and the head-piece tabletwoven. 67 tablets 96 ends per inch, pearl weft.



Goddess of Earth - Tablet woven trim lines the front opening of the coat and cuffs and can be seen at the neckline of the dress. 89 epi.
